(RADBURN BROW, CLAYTON-LE-WOODS, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in a South Easterly direction over that length of Radburn Brow, Clayton-le-Woods from A6 Preston Road, Clayton-le-Woods to Radburn Close, Clayton-le-Woods.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Thursday 12th September 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

A6 Preston Road, Clayton-le-Woods – A6 Preston Road, Whittle-le-Woods in a Southerly direction to Royton Drive, Whittle-le-Woods roundabout – A6 Preston Road, Whittle-le-Woods in a Northerly direction from Royton Drive, Whittle-le-Woods roundabout – A6 Preston Road, Clayton-le-Woods – B5256 Westwood Road, Bamber Bridge – Sandy Lane, Clayton-le-Woods – Radburn Brow, Clayton-le-Woods.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new telegraph pole installation works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals UK on behalf of BT.
