(GREGSON LANE, BRINDLE, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Gregson Lane, Brindle for a distance of 20m North West and South East of Mintholme Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 2330 hours on Saturday 21st September 2024 until 0830 hours on Sunday 22nd September 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for cyclists will be possible by dismounting and proceeding on foot.
- 4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Gregson Lane, Walton-le-Dale, South Ribble Borough – Daub Hall Lane, Walton-le-Dale, South Ribble Borough – Hoghton Lane, Walton-le-Dale (into Chorley Borough) – Hoghton Lane, Hoghton – The Straits, Hoghton – Hoghton Lane, Hoghton – Sandy Lane, Hoghton – Sandy Lane, Brindle – Hill House Lane, Brindle – Oram Road, Brindle – Gregson Lane, Brindle and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow rail corrosion inspection works at Mintholme Level Crossing to be carried out by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
